IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL WARNINGS AND INSTRUCTIONS IN THIS BOOK BEFORE USING THIS MACHINE! If you do not understand, ask your supervisor.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

- 1. DO NOT USE THIS VACUUM FOR PICK UP OF WET DEBRIS.
- 2. You must be trained to operate this machine. This machine is to be operated for its intended use only.
- 3. Do not operate this machine unless it is completely assembled.
- 4. Keep the machine surface dry. Do not subject to rain. Store the machine in a dry building area. Clean the machine with a dry cloth only.
- 5. Machines can cause an explosion when near flammable materials and vapors. Do not use or store this machine with or near fuels, grain dust, solvents, thinners, or other flammable materials. Do not use flammables to clean this machine.
- 6. Maintenance and repairs must be done by a qualified or authorized person.
- 7. If the machine is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center
- 8. Always use a three-wire electrical system connected to the electrical ground. For maximum protection against electrical shock, use a circuit that is protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter. Consult your electrical contractor.
- 9. To prevent electric shock, always remove the electrical plug from the electrical outlet before doing any repairs or maintenance and when leaving the machine unattended.
- 10. Do not pull cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Keep cord away from heated surfaces. Do not use with damaged cord or plug.
- 11. Keep the electrical parts of the machine dry.
- 12. Make sure all labels, decals, warnings, cautions and instructions are fastened to the machine.

Grounding Instructions

This machine must be grounded. If it should malfunction or break down, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This machine is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and grounding plug. The plug must be inserted into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

WARNING - Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or service person if you are in doubt as to whether the outlet is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the machine - if it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.


This machine is for use on a nominal 120-volt circuit, and has a grounded plug that looks like the plug illustrated in figure A. A temporary adapter that looks like the adapter illustrated in figures B and C may be used to connect this plug to a 2-pole receptacle as shown in figure B if a properly grounded outlet is not available. The temporary adapter should be used only until a properly grounded outlet (figure A) can be installed by a qualified electrician. The green colored rigid ear, lug, or the like extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box cover. Whenever the adapter is used, it must be held in place by a metal screw.

NOTE: In Canada, the use of a temporary adapter is not permitted by the Canadian Electrical Code

EXTENSION CORDS

Use only three-wire 14/3 or larger gauge approved extension cords that have three-prong grounding type plugs and three-pole receptacles that accept the appliance's plug. Replace or repair any damaged cords or plugs.

When servicing, refer to authorized person only. Use only identical replacement parts.



OPERATING PROCEDURES

WARNING! For the safe operation of this machine follow the instructions given in this booklet and the training given by your supervisor. Failure to do so can result in personal injury and/or damage to machine and property!

DO NOT OPERATE MACHINE IN AN EXPLOSIVE ENVIRONMENT!

WARNING! NEVER USE THIS MACHINE TO PICK UP VOLATILE OR EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS.

WARNING! DO NOT PICK UP WET MATERIAL WITH THIS MACHINE.

The model shown in this manual is intended for commercial use and for vacuuming dry material only.

PREPARATION

To prepare the machine for operation, make sure it is properly assembled. If in doubt, ask your supervisor.

Properly install the filter bag in the vacuum: Push the
filter bag inlet over the vacuum inlet elbow (item 8-receptacle) which is located on the bottom of the top
cover. Replace the filter bag when full.

OPERATION

- 1. Plug the machine's power cable into a properly grounded outlet (see Safety Instructions).
- 2. Connect the vacuum hose to the inlet port at the top of the machine. Note: The top cover can be rotated for left or right hand hose attachment.
- 3. Place the Back Pack Vacuum on your back by putting your arms through the straps. Adjust the straps to a comfortable working position. Then connect and adjust the waistband.
- **4. Attach the tool** of your choice to the working end of the vacuum hose. The tools included with the Back Pack Vacuum are the upholstery, dusting and crevice tools.
- **5. Turn ON the switch** (item 27) and begin your DRY pick up maintenance application.

MAINTENANCE

ALWAYS turn the machine power switch OFF and UNPLUG the power cord from the electrical outlet before doing any clean up or repairs, and when the machine is left unattended.

AFTER EACH USE:


 Inspect the filter bag. If the bag is full or damaged install a new one.

Filter Bag, 10 Pack – Part Number 620601 Cloth Bag (optional) – Part Number 620602

- Check the cord and plug for nicks, cuts or damage. Report these to your supervisor for correction. Also wrap the electrical cord and hang it on the strap provided (item 16).
- Store the machine in a clean dry area.

WEEKLY:


Inspect and clean the secondary filter assembly, item 10, part number 633301. This filter is constructed of foam over a plastic mounting ring. It is installed over the vacuum blower chamber located in the main housing. To remove the filter: slide it up and off the vacuum blower housing. To clean the filter: Do NOT wet the filter or blow the debris out with compressed air. Tap the filter lightly to remove the excess debris. Replace the filter if there are any rips or tears.

The **Pacific Steamex** Inc. Back Pack Vacuum has been manufactured, tested and inspected in accordance with specific engineering requirements and is WARRANTED to be free from defects in workmanship and materials as follows:

Five (5) years – Rotational molded components.

Two (2) years – Vacuum Motor

One (1) year – All other components unless excluded below.

This warranty extends to the original user/purchaser and only when used, operated and maintained in accordance with **Pacific Steamex** Inc. Operating and Maintenance instructions.

This warranty does not apply to the following wear parts and accessories of the machine including:
